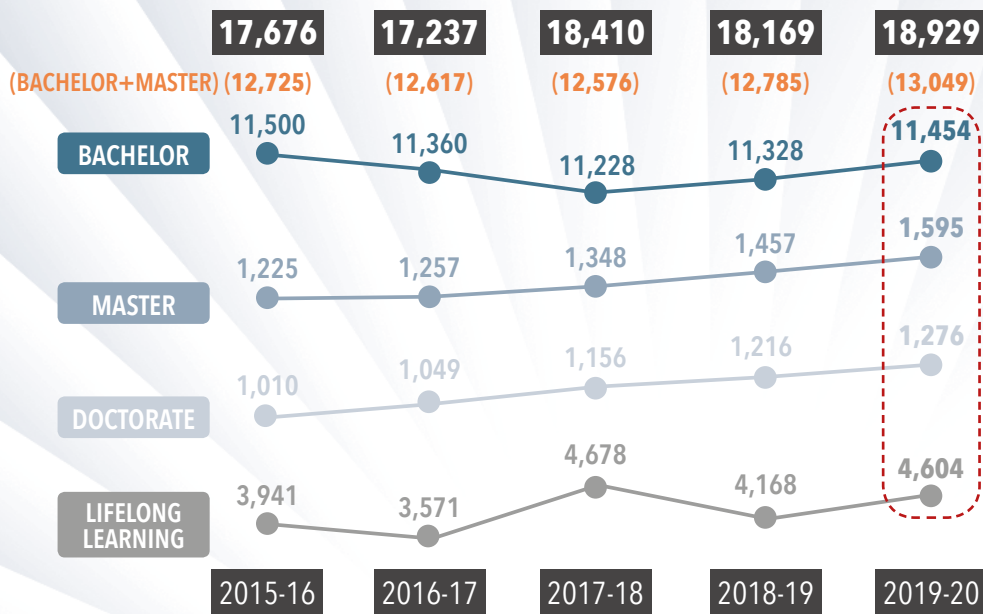

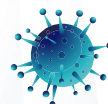

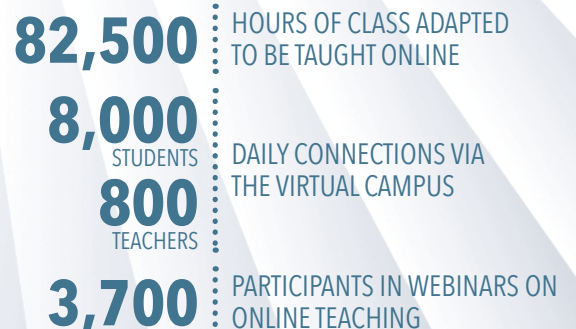


TEACHING MODEL

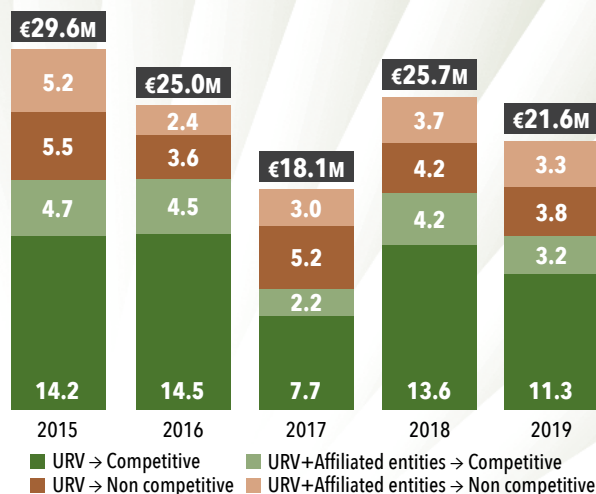

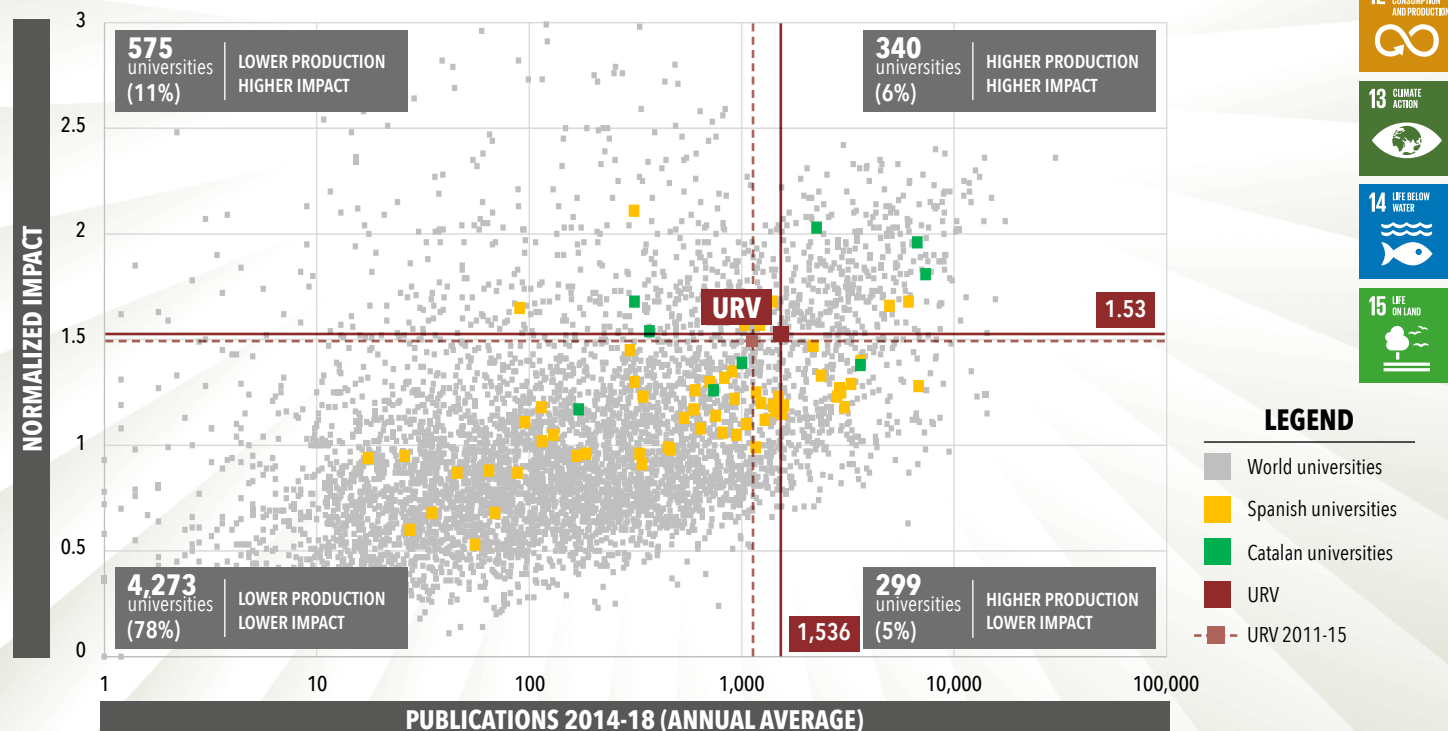
